Description:

Back In Stock Notifier Plugin is an extension of WooCommerce Plugins used to notify the users who subscribed for Back In Stock Notification, when the product comes Back In Stock. When the product comes back to stock it automatically sends the notification mail to those users who subscribed for the corresponding product.

Three Shortcodes are available with this Plugins. First one is the [site_title] for your Site name, second one is the [product_title] for your Product Name and third one is [product_url] you're Single Product URL. You can use the above Shortcodes in the text editor of Back In Stock email template.

Features:

- Automatically Send a Mail when product comes Back In Stock.
- Automatic /Manual Mail Notification.
- Turn the interested visitors into customers using the Back In Stock Notifier.
- Lists the number of subscribers to be notified for each Product using which you can understand the Product Priority for Restocking.
- Option to Clear Back In Stock Notify List After Success Notification.
- Different Types of Error Message Customization.
- Back In Stock lists subscribers in each Single Product page.
- Mail Subject and Message are Customizable in Admin Settings.
- Simple and Easy to Use.

How To Install:

There are two ways to install the Plugin. One is the Automatic Installation and another is the Manual Installation.

Automatic Installation:

- Automatic Installation is the easiest option as WordPress handles the file transfers and you don't even have to leave your web browser. To do an automatic install of Back In Stock Notifier log in to your WordPress admin panel and go to: **Plugins -> Add New**.
- In the "**Upload**" field browse Plugin zip folder "backinstocknotifier.zip" and click upload. You can install it by simply clicking **Install Now**. After clicking that link you will be asked to **Activate Plugin or Return to Plugins Page**. Click Activate Plugin and the installation will automatically complete.

Manual Installation:

- Unzip the Plugin zip file ("backinstocknotifier.zip").
- Using an FTP program or your hosting control panel, upload the unzipped Plugin folder to your WordPress installation's **wp-content/plugins** directory.
- The Plugin works once you click "**Activate**".
- Go to **Woocommerce → Settings → Back In Stock Notifier**

Requirements:

The minimum server requirements and the WordPress requirements are as follows

- PHP 5.2.4 or greater
- MySQL 5.0 or greater
- WordPress 3.4 or Higher

Browser Compatibility:

Back In Stock Notifier works fine with all major browsers such as IE8.0 +, Mozilla, Chrome, Safari, Opera etc.

Theme Compatibility:

Back In Stock should work fine with all the top woocommerce themes.

Setting Up Mail Notification:

There are two ways subscribers can be notified when Product Back In Stock

1. **Automatic Notification Mail** - "Process Notification Mail" is set to Automatic
2. **Manual Notification Mail** - "Process Notification Mail" is set to Manual

If you enable **Automatic Notification Mail** in the Settings Page, then you don't have to do anything apart from changing the stock status. When you change the stock to in stock, Mail Notification will be sent automatically to the Subscribers for whom the Selection Checkbox is ON.

If you enable **Manual Notification Mail** then after you change the stock status of product to in stock you have to send mail manually. To send the manual mail you have to click the "Send Notifications Now" button. This button will be available only when the "Process Notification Mail" is set to Manual on settings page.

Notification Mail will be sent to selected subscribers for both Automatic or Manual.



- Master List of All Subscribed Email IDs:** A table with columns: S.No, Email Id, Product, Date/Time, and a 'Delete Selected' button.
- Export Master Log of All Subscribed Email IDs:** A button.
- Troubleshooting:** Includes a 'Use Mail Function' dropdown and a 'Save changes' button.
